ACTION TAKEN REPORT (2019-20)

- Revised curriculum of affiliated university is implemented in B.Sc. Sem. V & Sem. VI (in Chemistry) as per semester pattern from this session.

- 1) Depth of the course content including assignment work is very good in all subjects because prescribed syllabus is uniform throughout India. The syllabus is UGC recognized. Only 20% course (syllabus) may be variable at university level as per BoS norms.
- 2) Applicability of course to real life is given by the students as per graph. It is in accordance with the subjects like MATHS-47 %, PHY- 51%, and CHE, 48% in rating 'A'.

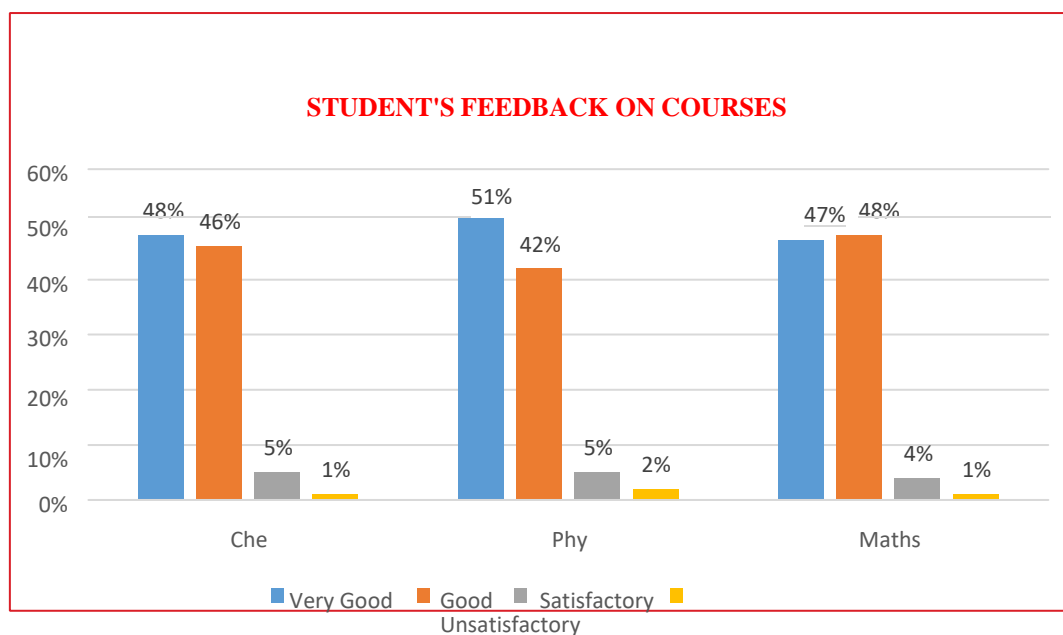


Fig:- 16 Course Analysis

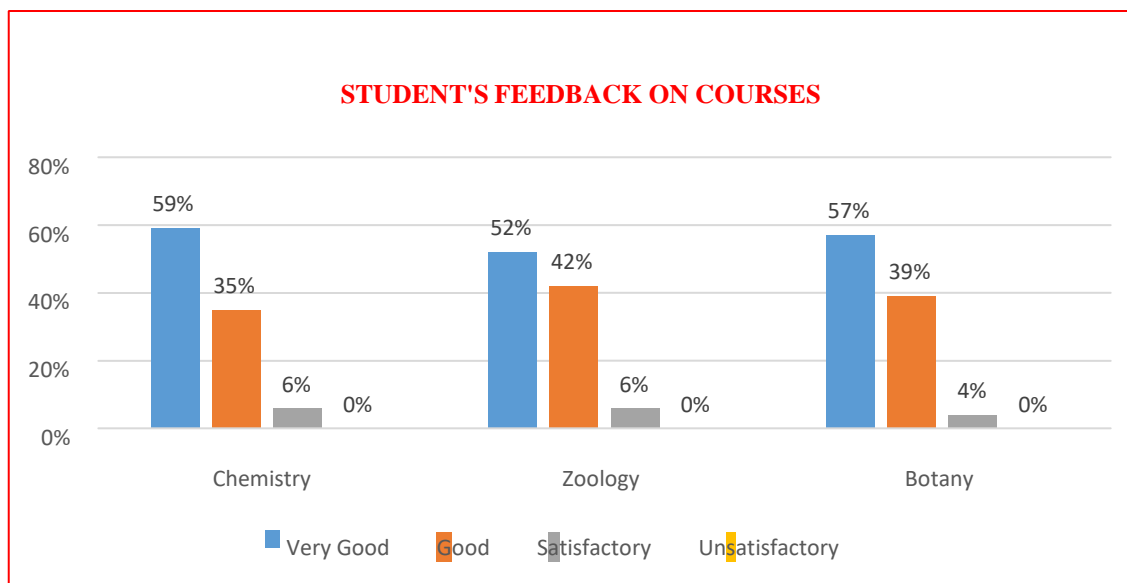


Fig:- 17 Course Analysis

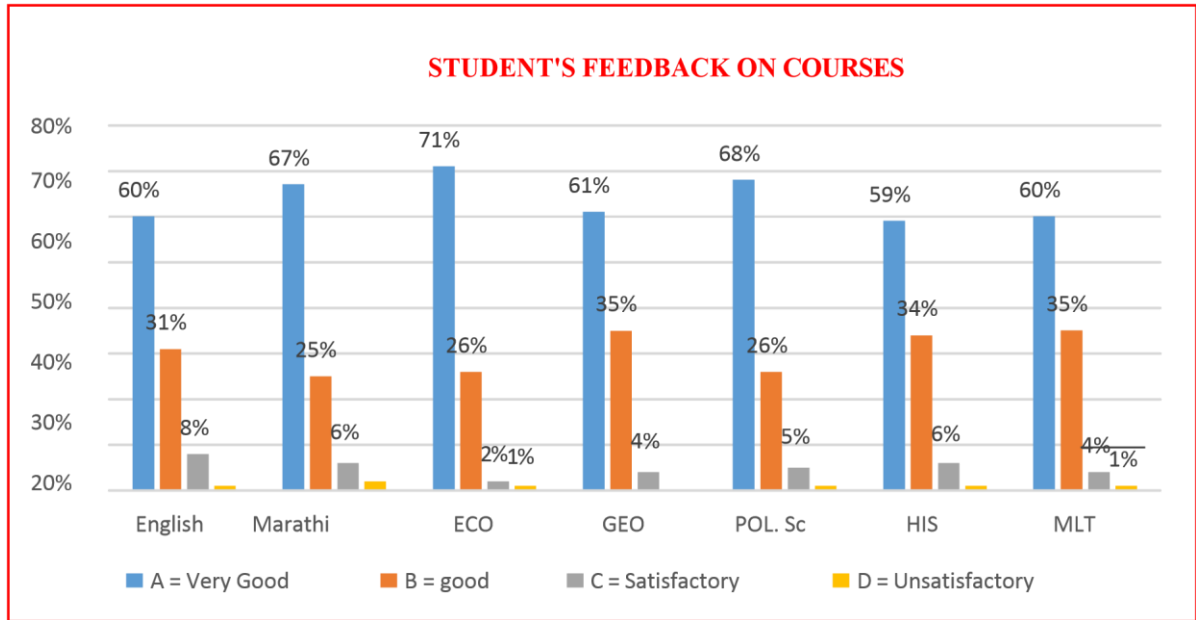


Fig:- 18 Course Analysis

- 1) Depth of the course content including assignment work is very good in all subjects because prescribed syllabus is uniform throughout India. The syllabus is UGC recognized. Only 20% course (syllabus) may be variable at university level as per BoS norms.
- 2) Applicability of course to real life is given by the students as per graph. It is in accordance with the subjects like C/A-71 %, M/P- 61%, F/A-72%, I/E-60%, CAT-60%, M/A-58%, A/S- 69% and IND/TAX-59% , in rating 'A'.

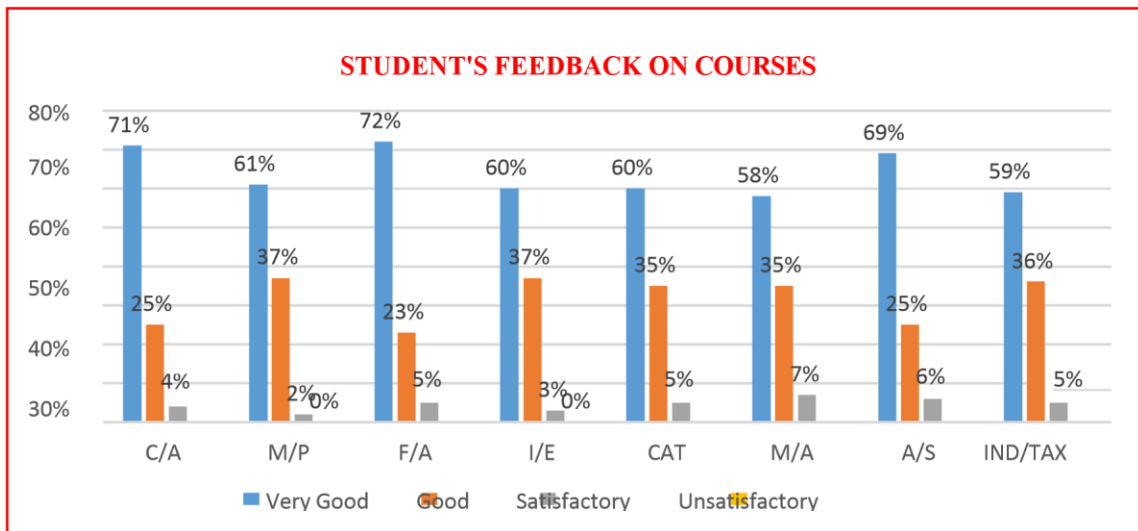



Fig:- 19 Course Analysis
